#### **Recommendations of ISO/IEC JTC1 SC 24/WG 8**

### to SC 24

# Resulting from the 2006 WG 8 Plenary Meeting in Prague, Czech Republic 6 June 2006

### Part 1: Progression of Work

## 1. Continuation of the Co-operation with the SEDRIS Organization

Whereas:

- a) co-operation during the last year between ISO/IEC JTC 1/SC 24 and the SEDRIS Organization has been productive and to the mutual benefit of both organizations;
- b) there is an additional SEDRIS-related standards project in process that emanates from the SEDRIS Organization and National Bodies, and therefore additional future work is anticipated.

Therefore:

ISO/IEC JTC 1/SC 24/WG 8 requests that SC 24 endorse the continued co-operation with the SEDRIS Organization in the development of additional ISO/IEC work items based on SEDRIS related standards.

# 2. Nomination of Editors for the new work item "Templates for SEDRIS DRM"

ISO/IEC JTC 1/SC 24/WG 8 nominates Mr. Youngsoo Kwon and a person to be nominated by the Korean NB as editors of the Technical Report for "Templates for the SEDRIS DRM".

## 3. Progression of Work of the SC 24/TC 211 Joint Task Force

ISO/IEC JTC 1/SC 24/WG 8 is pleased that the co-operation between SC 24 and TC211 through the Joint Task Force (JTF) has progressed effectively and recommends that SC 24 continue this cooperative activity to the fullest extent. Further, ISO/IEC JTC 1/SC 24/WG 8 recommends that Mr. Michael Leite continue as the co-convenor for SC 24 on the JTF.

#### 4. Progression of Work on Registries

ISO/IEC JTC 1/SC 24/WG 8 recommends the formation of rapporteur groups for SRM and SEDRIS registries.

ISO/IEC JTC 1/SC 24/WG 8 appoints Dr. Paul Berner to be the Rapporteur for the SRM registry.

ISO/IEC JTC 1/SC 24/WG 8 appoints either Mr. Youngsoo Kwon or Dr. Richard Puk as the Rapporteur for the SEDRIS registry.

ISO/IEC JTC 1/SC 24/WG 8 requests SC 24 to issue a call for experts for the SEDRIS and SRM registration rapporteur groups.

ISO/IEC JTC 1/SC 24/WG 8 reappoints Mr. Farid Mamaghani to be the Rapporteur for the EDCS registry.

ISO/IEC JTC 1/SC 24/WG 8 recommends the participation by SC 24 in the JTF with TC 211 should include the active participation by both parties in the development of joint and mutual procedures for the establishment and operation of registers.

## 5. Revision to ISO/IEC 18026 Spatial Reference Model

Whereas:

- a) a significant number of editorial defects and several technical inconsistencies have been identified in ISO/IEC 18026 SRM; and
- b) technical improvements in ISO/IEC 18026 SRM have been requested

Therefore:

ISO/IEC JTC 1/SC 24/WG 8 requests that SC 24 issue a corrigendum for ISO/IEC 18026 based on the SRM editors' report (WG8 N0439) on the technical inconsistencies and their proposed solution.

Furthermore, ISO/IEC JTC 1/SC 24/WG 8 advises SC 24 that it intends to raise a New Work Item, along with FCD text, to amend or revise ISO/IEC 18026 SRM to incorporate the editorial defects and technical improvements.

## 6. Proposal to Issue a Corrigendum for the EDCS Language Binding

ISO/IEC JTC 1/SC 24/WG 8 requests that the SC 24 Secretariat determine the status of the corrigendum for the EDCS Language Binding (ISO/IEC 18041-4) that was sent to him on 6-Oct-2005.

# 7. WG 8 to function as registry facility on behalf of the SEDRIS Organization until the 9973 amendment takes effect.

Whereas the revision to ISO/IEC 9973 has not yet been completed, ISO/IEC JTC 1/SC 24/WG 8 requests that it continue to be designated to act on behalf of the SEDRIS Liaison Organization for the submission of proposals to the SEDRIS-related registries.

# 8. Procedures for processing SRM and SEDRIS Registered Item proposals

In the anticipation of the fielding and operation of the SRM and SEDRIS registries, ISO/IEC JTC 1/SC 24/WG 8 recommends that the procedures defined in SC24 N2744 be adapted for the processing of SRM and SEDRIS Registered Item proposals.
