9. CHINA/BEIJING SPECIFIC INFORMATION

Information about Visas, Currency, Electricity supply etc. is provided in below.

8.1 Location

Address: International Education Communication Building, Beijing Institute of Technology, No.66 North 3rd Ring Road West, Beijing, China. International Education Communication Building is situated in the north gate of Beijing Institute of Technology, approximately 12.5 km northwest of the center of Beijing and 35 km southwest of Beijing capital international airport. Beijing Institute of Technology is located directly above Weigongcun underground Station, which is served by the 4th Line, Beijing Subway and several bus routes. For travel around Beijing, public transport is recommended for most journeys.

8.2 Access and Entry to International Education Communication Building / BIT

Access to the building is controlled. Visitors should report to the main reception desk and show a copy of the agenda/calling notice either in hard copy or electronic format. They will then be provided with a swipe card for accessing the building and the meeting room, which is valid for the period of the meeting. Staff, committee members and international delegates are required to display their swipe card at all times for identification purposes.

8.3 Currency exchange


Banking facilities in the immediate vicinity of International Education Communication Building are limited and it may be more convenient to exchange currency or travellers cheques before arriving at the meeting. All Chinese Banks including BC (Bank of China), CCB (China Construction Bank), ICBC (Industrial and Commercial Bank of China) and ABC (Agricultural Bank of China) and their branches, plus some other banks will transact financial affairs for foreigners. There is an ICBC bank just in the BIT.

8.4 Getting to International Education Communication Building / BIT from Beijing Capital International Airport

There are several ways to travel to International Education Communication Building/BIT from the airport. The simplest underground routes are given below.


8.4.1 Route 1:

- Take the Airport Bus to the Beijing Friendship Hotel;
- Walk to the International Education Communication Building.



8.4.2 Route 2:

- Take the Airport Express to the Sanyuanqiao Station;
- Transfer to the 10th line to the Haidianhuangzhuang Station;
- Transfer to the 4th line to the Weigongcun Station;
- Walk about 1.8km to the International Education Communication Building.



8.4.3 Route 3:

- Take the Airport Express to the Sanyuanqiao Station;
- Transfer to the 10th line to the Haidianhuangzhuang Station;
- Transfer to the 4th line to the Renmin University Station;
- Walk about 1.1km to the International Education Communication Building.

Notes come in denominations of \$1, \$5, \$10, \$20, \$50 and \$100.

Coins come in denominations of 1j, 5j and ± 1 .
