**Practical Information**

The meeting venue is the Czech Standards Institute, Biskupský dvůr 5, Praha 1 – it is marked with an arrow on the attached map. All hotels from the list as well as the meeting place are located in the city centre, the hotels are in walking distance from the meeting venue. Metro stations are in the vicinity .

The international airport of Prague, in Czech called Letiste Ruzyně, is located about 18 km from the city centre.

**Transportation from the Ruzyně airport to the meeting venue**

**By taxi**

You can take a taxi which costs about CZK 600. You are strongly advised to ask about the estimated price in advance and request the receipt.

**By public transport**

You can either take a bus No. 119 to the terminal station Dejvická, from here take a tram 26 to the stop called Bila labut, or a bus No. 100 to the terminus of Metro line B Zličín, from there go to the Metro station Florenc. Tickets for public transport should be bought in advance and validated in the metro station, bus or tram. Buy a transfer ticket for 20,- CZK.

You can also travel by airport minibuses operated by the company CEDAZ. They go every 30 minutes and will take you from the airport to the square “náměstí Republiky”, that is around 10 minutes from the meeting venue. You can buy a ticket for the price of 90 CZK ( for 1 person and 1 piece of luggage ) either at the arrival hall of the airport at the counter "CEDAZ" or from the bus driver.
